A BALANCED BUDGET FOR SOMERSET "When we won the local elections in May 2022, we knew we had a huge challenge ahead of us," said Cllr Oliver Patrick. "It was always going to be difficult to combine all 5 councils into 1 new Unitary Council, but it has been made especially difficult with demand for services, particularly in adult social care and children's services, soaring along with high inflation, and ongoing Covid and Brexit workforce challenges."

Following the Full Council meeting on 22 February Somerset now has a **balanced budget** for 2023/24, the first year of the new Unitary Council. "We have delivered a solid foundation for Somerset's new Council" said **Oliver**, "Our

balanced budget protects core services, shields those on the lowest incomes, and invests in Somerset."

"We are a listening Council" added Cllr Mike Hewitson, "we listened to community concerns about our plans to change the way grit is delivered to villages and have committed to continue paying for this important service."

FREE CO₂ MONITORS FOR LOCAL BUSINESSES So far Oliver has



donated ten CO₂ monitors to a number of Early Years settings, cafes, pubs, village halls, and even a youth club in Coker Division. "Keep your eyes peeled!" says **Oliver** "and you might spot one when you're out and about!"

In order to encourage good ventilation in classrooms, the Department for Education distributed CO₂ monitors to

schools just before Christmas. Oliver thought that all public places could benefit from this, so he began using his clean air fund to buy CO₂ monitors to give away for free. **Oliver's** clean air campaign has now raised just over £5,500.

"It's such a simple idea," says **Oliver**, "when CO_2 goes high you open the windows to bring CO_2 levels down. Doing this can help stop the spread of airborne infections like Covid, flu, and common colds."
